Physical development (Moving and handling, health and self care)

- Showing an awareness of how to keep safe in the sun.
- Preparing for Sports Day
- Continuing to develop the skills to control an object in pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking
- Realising the importance for good health through physical exercise and a healthy diet

Communication and Language (Speaking, Listening and Understanding)

- Anticipating key events, responding to what they hear with relevant comments, questions and actions
- Continuing to answer how and why questions about their experiences and in response to stories or events
- Continuing to express themselves effectively, showing awareness of the listener
- Using past, present and future forms accurately

What a Wonderful World (April to July)

Literacy (Reading and Writing)

- Continuing to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately.
- Reading some common irregular words, demonstrating an understanding of what they have read
- Writing words that match their spoken sound. Writing some common irregular words. Writing sentences that can be read by themselves and others

Mathematics (Numbers, space, shape and measure)

- Saying the number that is one more or one less than a given number
- Adding and subtracting two single digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer
- Solving problems including doubling, halving and sharing
- Talking about size, weight, capacity position, distance, time and money

Our Long Term Vision in the Foundation Stage is based upon a rolling programme, where 'topics' are identified and developed according to the children's interests, whilst ensuring coverage of the EYFS framework. Medium-term planning, based on these topics, is then produced thinking about the children's learning using the 'Development Matters' objectives and the Early Learning Goals in the Summer Term.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (Self confidence and self awareness, managing feeling and behaviour, making relationships)

- Describing themselves in positive terms, talking about their abilities
- Working as part of a group, understanding and following rules
- Taking into account others ideas about how to organise an activity
- SEAL Going for Goals (Summer 1) and Changes - preparing for Year 1 (Summer 2)

Expressive Art and Design (Exploring and using media and materials, being imaginative)

- Continuing to build a repertoire of songs for the Year 2 Leavers Concert
- Experimenting to make and change music and create movement
- Representing their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through D&T, art, music, dance, stories and role play

Understanding the World (People and communities, The world, Technology)

- Discussing past and present events in their own lives and the lives of family members
- Recognising similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things
- Talking about their immediate environment and how environments vary from one another
- Observing plants and animals and explaining why some things occur and talk about change
